General Reports

D'FAT Meeting: Nic explained that last week's scheduled meeting was cancelled due to no quorum and so tonight's meeting is being held.

D'FAT Minutes: It was agreed by a majority to accept the minutes from 4/4/19 meeting.

D'FAT Clothing: Matt presented quote from Badges Make Badges for aprons for \$375.65.

It was agreed by a majority to purchase aprons from Slick Promotions.

D’FAT Chat; It was agreed for Nic to create a template for D’FAT Chat articles.

D’FACTS with D’FAT; Jasmine reported that she hosted the program by herself last week. Nic and Jasmine hosted the program the week prior. Nic trained Jasmine on how to use the radio studio.

FEDS; Matt has once again reported the broken bin and the uncovered pipe at Ellis Dean Reserve. It was suggested to write to the Council Maintenance Supervisor on the unfinished basketball area. It was agreed by a majority to do so.

Graffiti Wall Management; Nic reported that he and Matt painted black the sides of the graffiti wall that had offensive and abusive graffiti on 7th April. Amy and Jasmine has viewed the wall today and last Thursday and there was not any offensive or abusive graffiti.
