Eligibility of Fees	
All fees must be paid within a prescribed time period. In accordance with Section 8(1) of the <i>Dog Control Act 2000</i> it is a requirement for any dog over the age of six months to be registered. Failure to do so may result in an infringement notice being issued. Please note, this requirement is in addition to having your dog microchipped.	
<b>Note:</b> The owner of a dog that is aged over 6 months that is unregistered is guilty of an offence and is liable to an on the spot fine of one (1) penalty point or on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding five (5) penalty points.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR DISCOUNTED FEES

All fees must be paid within a prescribed time period.

**PENSIONERS**– The standard registration fee eligibility is for a maximum of 2 domestic dogs only per household and on production of a Commonwealth Pensioner Concession Card or Repatriation Health Card. Any additional dog kept by the card holder is at the applicable rate.

**DESEXED** – Owners must produce a veterinarian certificate at the time of initial registration.

**SPECIAL ASSISTANCE** – Evidence will be required that sight, hearing or any other special needs dog, has or is being trained by an approved institution.

**ALL DOGS SIX MONTHS AND OVER MUST BE REGISTERED AND MICROCHIPPED.**  
**If your dog is not registered and microchipped, you may be issued with an on the spot fine.**
