

Advice on Nominating

Nominations may be submitted by groups (e.g. committees, associations etc.) or individuals using this nomination form.

These awards place emphasis on what the person/group has done for the community in a voluntary capacity, rather than as part of normal duties in a paid occupation.

All areas on this form must be completed to enable fair consideration to all nominees.

Please give accurate details of the person or group's involvements i.e. specify roles performed by the nominee, indicate their personal degree of involvement and outline how their leadership benefited the community.

It is important to provide *specific* examples of how the nominee's contributions have been outstanding.

Awards will be presented by the Mayor at the Derwent Valley Council Australia Day Awards ceremony to be held on Tuesday, 26 January 2021.

Eligibility Criteria

Council, through its Australia Day Committee, will give consideration to the eligibility of individuals and groups for recognition against the criteria below:

- All Nominees must be Australian Citizens
- Nominees for Young Citizen of the Year must be under 27 years
- Nominees for Citizen of the Year must be between 27 years and 59 years
- Nominees for Senior Citizen of the Year must be 60 years or older
- Ages above are as at 26 January of the Awards year
- Nominees must have lived in the Derwent Valley municipality when this application is written
- Nominations must be on official nomination application and received prior to the close of nominations
- Self-nominations will not be accepted
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years
- Nominations may be held over for a period of 2 years at the discretion of the Australia Day Committee
- A person or group may not receive a second award in the same award category
