 - Traffic Management Application (if applicable)
- Works are not to commence until the Permit has been issued.
- The permit is valid for 6 months from the Date of Issue
- It is the responsibility of the applicant to locate and protect any services within the road reserve before commencing work.
- The stormwater connection is to be constructed in accordance with the Local Government Association of Tasmania's (LGAT) Standard Drawings and relevant Australian Standards and Guidelines.
- Any alternations or works performed on Council's stormwater system must remain uncovered until the
 completion of the inspection. If there is failure to provide notification in advance or to expose the connection
 for the visual inspection, Council may choose to expose the connection(s) and reinstate after the inspection
 at full cost to the applicant.
- On completion of the works the site must be returned to its original condition to the satisfaction of Council.
